The following bylaws are made by the Nadia Zilla Parishad under Sec. 223 of West Bengal Panchayat Act 1973 read with Sec-181 of West Bengal Panchayat Act 1973 and Rule 90(4) of West Bengal (Zilla Parishad and Panchayat Samity) Accounts and Finance Rule 2003 to impose Fee, Rate, Charge, Surcharge etc. for the purpose of raising fund and building assets in order to discharge responsibilities as laid down under Sec. 153 of West Bengal Panchayat Act 1973.

MODIFIED BYLAWS OF NADIA ZILLA PARISHAD

- 1) The modified Bylaws will be recognized as “Nadia Zilla Parishad By-Laws”.
- 2) These By-Laws will be applicable to the entire area under jurisdiction of Nadia Zilla Parishad.
- 3) These Bylaws shall come into effect from the date of the General Meeting of Nadia Zilla Parishad held on 30-06-2006 after the approval of Artha-Sanstha-Unnayan-O-Parikalpana-Sthayee-Samity (A-S-U-O-P-S-S) meeting of Nadia Zilla Parishad held on 02-12-2005.

Bylaws:

4. DEFINITION: In this Bylaw, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject of context;

- 1) The “Parishad” means Zilla Parishad, Nadia constituted under section 140 of the West Bengal Panchayat Act, 1973.
- 2) The work “Cattle” has the same meaning as in the Cattle-Trespass Act, 1971;
- 3) “Reserved tank or well” means a tank or well which the District Board has set apart under section 90 of the Bengal Local Self-Government Act of 1885, by public notice, for the supply of water for drinking and for culinary purposes, and includes any reservoir, or part of any river, canal or other channel, so set apart, and a notice-board on the edge of a reserved tank or well, containing the words “reserved tank” or “reserved well”, or words to that effect, shall be deemed to be sufficient notice for the purpose of this definition; and
- 4) The “slopes” of a reserved tank or well include all places from which water can flow directly into such tank or well; and
- 5) “Road” means a road vested in, or under the control and administration of, the Parishad; and includes
 - a) A Village Road;
 - b) The slope, berm, borrow-pits and side-drains or a road; and

- c) All land vested in, or under the control and administration of the Parishad, and attached to a road.

I. ROADS, DRAINS, BRIDGES CANALS AND EMBANKMENTS

5. Encroachments or Obstruction on Roads and Lands:-

- 1) No person shall encroach on any part of a road or land by cultivating crops thereon.
- 2) No person by means of any building, fence, pit, embankment or ditch or any other obstruction, on any road or land or by means of any cut, drain or water course thereon intended for the purpose of drainage or irrigation, or by exposing thereon any goods for sale, or by placing thereon any substance or material.
 - a) Without the permission of the Zilla Parishad, make or cause any encroachment, or
 - b) Obstruct traffic, or
 - c) Cause any inconvenience to passengers, or
 - d) Hinder or impede the flow of water.

6. Acquisition of Land :- When Parishad requires land to carry out any activities, it may negotiate with the person or persons having interest in the said land and if it fails to reach an agreement, it may acquire such land under the provision of Section 175 of the West Bengal Panchayat Act, 1973.

7. Leasing /Licensing of immovable property of Nadia Zilla Parishad: -

i) Leasing /Licensing of immovable property:-

The Parishad may issue lease /licence on any immovable property vested in it or placed under it's control and management for a term not exceeding 5 (five) years for carrying out activities to socio-economic importance on payment of annual lease / licence fee and on such terms and conditions as it may determine at its meeting and such lease/ licence can not be issued to the same person for more than 10 years. However, long-term lease may be given to Govt./ Semi Govt. organization with the approval of Nadia Zilla Parishad. Renewal shall be made subject to fulfillment of prevailing terms and conditions and payment to enhanced Licence fee. In case of any dispute Nadia Zilla Parishad will take decision.

ii) Priority in granting lease /licence of land of Nadia Zilla Parishad shall be given to the immediate adjoining landowner, if several persons apply for grant of licence for same land. If the adjoining owner is unwilling to take lease / licence of the land it will be open for the Nadia Zilla Parishad to grant lease/licence to others provided the access to the adjoining owner of the Nadia Zilla Parishad land shall not be obstructed. If one out of two adjoining landowners applies for grant of lease / license, he will be granted lease/licence without causing obstruction to the access of the other adjoining landowner. If both the adjoining landowners apply for grant of lease/licence, Nadia Zilla Parishad may in its discretion grant

lease/license to either of them or both without causing inconveniences to egress and ingress to any adjoining landowner.

iii) Under no circumstances, the nature and the character of Nadia Zilla Parishad land shall be changed. In the event of any change of nature and character of leased out/ licensed land, necessary action will be taken as per existing statutory provision.

iv) After expiry of the period of lease/licence, the possession of Nadia Zilla Parishad land shall be deemed to have been vested in the authority of Nadia Zilla Parishad and in the event of renewal of Lease /Licence or grant of fresh Lease/ Licence, the possession is required to be given to the Lessee/Licensee afresh.

v) For fresh Licence after expiry of 10 years (for the same person) this Parishad may consider for handing over Licence to the family members of the old Lessee. (Family member includes Wife / Husband / Son / Unmarried Daughter) but this is not mandatory. In this case a fresh application form is to be submitted by the concerned member of the family to this Parishad for consideration of Licence.

vi) The Lease/Licence shall only be entitled to use the land for own purpose on permissive basis and the Lessee/Licensee under no circumstances shall be entitled to transfer or sell or let out whole or any portion of the leased/licensed land to any third party/ Outsiders and if is detected that the Lessee / Licensee has transferred/ sold / let out possession to Third Party Nadia Zilla Parishad shall take over possession terminating the Lease / Licence unilaterally. In addition to that Nadia Zilla Parishad may impose penalty as will be decided in its meeting.

vii) Under no circumstances person / Lessee concerned will not be entitled to transfer the possession of the land to any other persons.

8. Sale, Collecting or Gathering of Articles in the vicinity of Road :-

No person shall expose or place any article in any bazaar or market in the vicinity of a road, or collect or gather any article in the vicinity of a road, so as to interface with the traffic of road.

9. Cutting of plants, trees or hedges obstructing road or drain or overhanging

on lands: - Any person in possession of, or having control over, any plants, trees, or hedges obstructing, overhanging and overshadowing any road, or public drain or any sluice, or drain connected with a public drain, or any land shall, if so required by notice in writing, signed by the Parishad authority, cut down, prune or trim such plants, trees or hedges, within the period and in the manner specified in such notice.

10. Damages to bridges, culverts, or causeways on road :- 1) No person shall--

- a) Destroy or damage, or cause to be destroyed or damaged any bridge, culvert, or causeway built on or across any road; or
 - b) Erect any fence or other object on, or against or close to the opening of, any such bridge, culvert or causeway, for any purpose, so as to impede the free flow of water there-under, or so as to cause damage thereto; or
 - c) Cast nets for fishing purposes from any parapet of any such bridge or culvert.
- 11. Damage to fences, posts, soil-turf of grass on road: -** No person shall-----
- a) Destroy or damage, or cause to be destroyed or damaged any fence or post created on any road; or
 - b) Dig, scrape, uproot or remove any soil-turf or grass from any part of a road.
- 12. Channel across road: -**
- 1) No person shall cut a channel or convey water by a channel across any road, except with the permission of the Parishad.
 - 2) Any person who has been permitted by the Parishad for any specific purpose to cut and maintain for any period a channel across a road, shall on the expiry of such period, cover or refill the channel so as to restore the road to its former condition and until then maintain the channel cut by him in a proper condition so as not to materially interfere with the normal use of the road.
 - 3) Any person who has a prescriptive right to keep a channel open for carrying water across a road shall keep the channel in proper order, so as to prevent danger or inconvenience to the public.
- 13. Obstruction of waterway adjoining road: -** No person shall obstruct any waterway adjoining a road so as to injure or intend to injure the road and boundary or otherwise render the road impassable.
- 14. Excavations on or near road: -**
- 1) No person shall make any excavation on any road and land boundary, or shall dig any hole, pit, tank or well within fifteen feet of any road, without the permission of the Parishad.
 - 2) Any person who is permitted to excavate or dig under Sub-Rule (1) above shall be bound to take such order therewith as will prevent damage to, or erosion of the road.
- 15. Protection of excavation on or near road: -** The owner or occupier of any tank, well, or other excavation on or near the side of any road shall be bound to fence in or duly protect such excavation in such manner as may be directed by notice signed by the Parishad authority.
- 16. Use of roads, bridges, culverts or canals while closed to traffic: -** No person shall pass over, or drive any animal or vehicle over, any road, bridge, culvert, or canal, so as to injure the same while it is under construction or repair or is affected by flood or is otherwise rendered unfit for traffic and is closed to traffic under the orders of the Parishad, Nadia.

- 17. Discharge of Rainfall from Roof to Road :-** No person shall without the permission of the Zilla Parishad, Nadia allow the rainwater to be discharged from the roof of any building owned or occupied by him upon any road by means of a spout, pipe or other article intended for the conveyance of water.
- 18. Flow of filth to Road :-** No person shall allow the water of any privy, or any matter offensive or deleterious to health, to flow on any road.
- 19. Removal of Trees or erections falling on to road :-** Any person owing or possessing a tree or a house, wall or other erection which has fallen, or part of which has fallen, on to a road or any land, shall, if so required by notice in writing signed by Parishad authority, remove such tree, house, wall, erection or part thereof within period specified in such notice.
- 20. Curing hides on or near road :-** No person shall cure hides on or within fifty feet of any road.
- 21. Slaughter of Animals, Cleaning of Carcass etc., on or near Road :-** No person shall slaughter any animal, or clean any Carcass, or Deposit or Collect Bones, Flesh or hides on or within fifty feet of any road.
- 22. Placing or Burning Bodies on Road :-** No person shall place or burn any corpse or carcass on or near any road.
- 23. Steeping offensive matter in road-side drain, pit or excavation :-** No person shall steep any jute, hemp, bamboo, hide or other offensive matter in any drain, barrow-pit or excavation at the side of any road.
- 24. Care of Vehicles on Road :-**
- 1) No person shall drive in his charge on any road more than one vehicle at a time.
 - 2) No person in charge of, or having control over, any vehicle, shall allow it to stand unattended on any road.
 - 3) No person shall leave a vehicle standing on a road for any time longer than what is necessary for loading or unloading it.
 - 4) No person shall drive upon a road any vehicles laden with bamboos, planks, or other materials of similar character, which exceed twelve feet in length and project beyond the vehicle, unless he is accompanied also by another person.
 - 5) Owners and Drivers of Vehicles loaded with bricks or other materials shall be responsible for their being so secured that the contents thereof may not fall down on any road.
 - 6) If any vehicle breaks down on a road, the driver shall remove it to the edge of the road without delay and shall, within a reasonable time, remove from the road all materials, if any, which have fallen from the vehicle and shall place the vehicle in such a position that it may not obstruct traffic.

- 7) No person shall load or drive any vehicle up or down the slopes of any road except at crossing fixed by the Parishad.

25. Care of Animals on Road:

- i) No person in charge of, or having control over, any animal used for riding or draught shall allow such animal to stand or to keep on any road without a rider or driver.
- ii) No person in charge of, or having control over, any cattle shall allow such cattle to stray or lie on any road so as to cause inconveniences or danger to any person traveling on the road.
- iii) No person shall tether any cattle on, or within reach of, a road allow cattle to graze on a road.

26. Care of Children on Road :- No parent or other person for the time being in charge of any child under five years of age shall allow such child to stray on any road so as to cause obstruction or risk or obstruction to traffic.

27. Carrying Bamboos or Ballahs on Cart or Road :- No person shall carry bamboos or ballahs on a cart or any vehicle on any road in such a manner so as to scrape the road, or to cause injury or annoyance, or risk of injury, to travelers thereof.

28. Transport of heavy vehicle or loads over Bridges and Culverts :-

- 1) No person shall drive a vehicle with materials, total weight exceeding five tons, over any bridge or culvert except with the special permission of the Parishad.
- 2) The Parishad shall have power to stop the movement of any type of heavy vehicle on any road if such movement is considered to damage such roads or cause unsanitary condition to local people. Whenever such restrictions are imposed, proper notice board will be arranged at the site by the Parishad authority.

29. Width of Tyres :- No bullock cart shall travel on any road, unless the iron tyres of the wheels, or in the case of carts not having iron rims, the wooden rings of the wheels, are two inches or more in width.

30. Lighting of Vehicles on road :- Every carriage drawn by a horse or horses, every wagon drawn by any other animals or propelled by power, and every motor car, motor bus or motor lorry shall carry two conspicuous lights, one on either side and every two-wheeled cart and every bicycle and tricycle shall carry one conspicuous light when traveling on a road between dusk and dawn.

31. Nuisance on roads and lands :- No person shall commit any nuisance on any road or any land.

32. Levy of Fees for approval of Building Plan/ Site Plan :-

- a) Where approval of Plan or permission for erection of a new structure or a new building or to make any addition to an existing building or establishment of an industry

of whatsoever nature is required from the Parishad under provisions of any existing rules, the applicant shall apply to the Parishad along with a plan of the proposed structure or building, a site plan, copy of records-of-Rights and copy of such other records showing title and interest of the applicant in respect of the Land as may be necessary. No such application shall be considered by the Parishad unless such application is accomplished by a receipt against fee paid by the applicant at the following rates as may be applicable.

b) The Nadia Zilla Parishad will have the authority to introduce Building Plan rules to be finalized & approved in its meeting in due course.

II) TREES

33. Damage to trees :- No person shall destroy or damage or cause to be destroyed or damaged -----

- a) Any tree planted by or under the charge of the Parishad or standing any road and land of the Parishad, or
- b) Any gabion or others defensive enclosure erected for the production of any such tree.

34. Tapping, or taking fruit from trees on road :- No person shall tap any date or palm tree, or remove fruit from any tree planted by or under control of the Parishad or standing on any road of the Parishad without a lease or written permission previously obtained from or on behalf of the Parishad.

III) FIRES

35. Lighting of fire :- No person shall light a fire in any unenclosed place within ten yards of any wooden bridge vested in the Parishad.

IV) WATER-SUPPLY RESERVED FOR DRINKING AND CULINARY PURPOSES:

36. Taking of Water :- No person shall take water from a reserved tank or well except for drinking or culinary purpose save with express permission of the Parishad.

37. Bathing or Washing :- No person shall -----

- a) Bathe or wash any portion of his own body or the body of any other person; or
- b) Wash clothes; or
- c) Wash any cattle or other animal; or
- d) Allow of his ducks, geese or other birds to enter the water in any reserved tank or well, or upon any of the banks, slopes, or sides of any reserved tank or well.

38. Fouling of Water :- No Person shall -----

- 1. Commit any nuisance in, or on the banks or slopes or sides of any reserved tank or well; or
- 2. Throw any filthy substance thereinto; or
- 3. In any way pollute the water thereof; or
- 4. Allow the water of any sink, sewer, cesspool or privy or any offensive matter belonging to him or being in his hand, to flow thereinto; or
- 5. Steep jute or bamboo in or on the banks or slopes or side of any reserved tank or well.

39. Overhanging trees or vegetation :- No person shall allow any tree, bamboo or other vegetation growing on land in his occupation to overhang any reserved tank or well so far

to foul the water thereof, or shall fail to cut and remove the same after reasonable notice in that behalf from the Parishad.

40. Removal of earth or grass from sides or slopes :- No person shall cut sods or grass, or remove earth or grass from, or otherwise damage, the sides or slopes of any reserved tank or well without the expressed permission of the Parishad.

41. Cultivation on banks, sides or slopes of reserved tanks and wells :- No person shall cultivate on the banks, sides or slopes of a reserved tank or well or any tank or water areas placed under the control of Parishad except in such manner as may be approved by the Parishad.

42. Building on banks, sides or slopes of reserved tanks or wells :- No person shall erect any hut or house or other structure upon the banks, sides or slopes of a reserved tank or well or any tank or water areas placed under the control of Parishad without the permission of the Parishad.

43. Levy of rates for the supply of water :- Where arrangement for the supply of water for drinking, irrigation or any other purpose is made by the Parishad within its jurisdiction, a water-rate shall be paid by the users or by the persons having interest of any nature thereof under Section 181 of West Bengal Panchayat Act'73 at the rate as will be determined by the Parishad at its meeting.

44. Dams, stakes and fishing apparatus :- No person shall construct dams, fix stakes or place fishing net or apparatus across, or in, any reserved tank or well, or any part of a river, canal or other channel set apart for the supply of water for drinking and culinary purpose.

45. Fishing in reserved tanks and wells :- No person shall catch or attempt to catch fish in a reserved tank or well or any tank or water areas placed under the control of Parishad without the permission of the Parishad.

V) FAIRS & MELAS

46.

1. Licences for Fairs & Melas:

The owner or licence of every fair or mela or the owner or license of a land intending to hold a fair or mela thereon shall, under Section 181(1)(c)(3) and 162 of West Bengal Panchayat Act, 1973, shall apply to the Parishad for a licence and shall pay a fee Rs. 500 per day.

2. Licence bound by the condition of License:

The Licensee shall be bound by the conditions of the licence granted to the licensee.

VI) REGISTRATION OF BOATS

47.

1) Fees for registration of Boats:

The owner of every boats specified below which is kept or is used in the ordinary course of business or which has been let for hire within or without the jurisdiction of the Parishad shall apply for registration of such boat to the Parishad and shall pay the following annual fee for such registration & renewal under Sec. 181(1)(c)(1) of West Bengal Panchayat Act. 1973

B	A passenger Boat plied by two (2) Mallas	Rs. 20.00
C	A passenger Boat plied by three (3) Mallas	Rs. 30.00

F	A Cargo Boat	Rs. 300.00

The Registration No. shall be noted on the Boat at a conspicuous place.

2. Lessee/ owner bound by condition of Registration:

The Lessee/Owner of a boat so registered, shall be bound by the conditions of the registration granted to the owner/lessee.

VI) LEAVY OF TOLLS ON ROADS AND FERRIES.

48.

1. Every person crossing a ferry established by the Parishad or under its management shall pay a toll under Sec. 181(1)(b) of West Bengal Panchayat Act. 1973 (for each case in Rs.)

The rate of toll shall be displayed on both side of Ferry Ghat.

2. At every toll bar established by the Parishad on any road (Excepting Kancha or village road) or any bridge vested in or managed by it, a toll shall be paid at the following rates for a motor lorry, truck, tractor, with or without trailer, trekker, matador and delivery van by the person in charge of the vehicle under Section 181(1)!a) of the Act XLI of 1973.

Provided that no toll shall be levied upon the vehicles of the following categories:

- a) For vehicle owned or hired by the Govt. of West Bengal or Govt. of India.
- b) For vehicle owned or hired by the Zilla Parishad, Nadia.
- c) For vehicle owned or hired by the Panchayat Bodies.
- d) For vehicle owned or hired by local bodies such as municipality, notified area authority.
- e) Any vehicle carrying dead bodies.

VII) LEVY OF FEE FOR PROVIDING SANITARY ARRANGEMENTS AT PLACES OF WORSHIP, PILGRIMAGES, FAIRS AND MELAS

49. Fees for providing Sanitary arrangements:

For providing arrangements of water, sanitation, parking place etc. at any place of worship or pilgrimage or tourist attraction, fees at the following rates shall be charged under 181 (1)(c)(2) of the West Bengal Panchayat Act 1973 from the pilgrims, the person in charge of an animal and the vendor as the case may be visiting or staying in the place shall be charged on following rates for urinal & latrine.

VIII) HEALTH

50.

1. Nadia Zilla Parishad may run its medical unit according to the policy and scheme adopted from time to time by running charitable dispensary in rural area or in such other places as the Parishad shall decide from time to time.

2. Nadia Zilla Parishad may also in order to serve medical assistance to people, arrange for issuing tickets at a minimum rate of Rs. 2/= per ticket on each day for each patient and in regard to upward revision, enhancement may be made upto Rs. 5/= subject to resolution taken in Nadia Zilla Parishad Meeting.

IX) HAT & MARKET

51.

1. Zilla Parishad may supervise, acquire and maintain any village hat and market according to Section 153(vii) of the West Bengal Panchayat Act 1973.
2. Zilla Parishad shall be entitled to charge or levy development fees for traders of Market/Hat situated on its own land or any other land acquired & maintained by Zilla Parishad at a rate be fixed by Zilla Parishad in its meeting which shall be reviewed from time to time. There shall be an agreement between traders and the Zilla Parishad on such terms & conditions as may be determined by Zilla Parishad.

X) GENERAL

52.

1. The District Engineer of this Parishad is hereby empowered by the Sabhadhipati of this Parishad to Sanction all the New Building plan duly submitted by the applicant as per rules of this byelaws and to serve notice to all the Unauthorized Constructions which are previously Constructed or are under construction without sanctioned plan from this Parishad; after getting reports from concerned Assistant Engineer and Sub-Assistant Engineer and to take decision in consultation with the Building Plan Committee of this Parishad to be constituted by the Parishad in its meeting.
2. Zilla Parishad shall charge a non-refundable fee for Registration and renewal from the registered Zilla Parishad Contractors at the rates stated below in terms of Rule 90(4) of the West Bengal Panchayat (Zilla Parishad & Panchayat Samity) Accounts & Finance Rules, 2003 read with Sec. 224 of West Bengal Panchayat Act,1973.

XI) MISCELLANEOUS

53.

1. The Zilla Parishad may from time to time enhance the rate of license fee, toll, cess development fees, levy etc. as will be decided in its meeting.
2. The Zilla Parishad may from time to time change, revise, modify, include/delete any clause / terms recital in the proforma / saving contents of form, agreement or any other document to be executed or required to be done by Nadia Zilla Parishad.
3. The Zilla Parishad may from time to time look into the affairs and take action against industry, business or residential and commercial accommodation to avoid nuisance, pollution and for maintaining environmental equilibrium with the help of District Administration.
4. The Zilla Parishad shall formulate specific Building Bylaws to transact its business, which will form part of this bylaw.

XII) PENALTIES

Penalty for breach of Bylaw:

A breach of the bylaw except Building bylaw mentioned herein shall be punishable with fine, which may extend to one hundred rupees, and in the case of a continuing breach with a further fine which may extend to ten rupees for everyday during which the breach continues after the offender has been convicted of such breach.
